AMENDED ARTICLES OF COOPERATION OF

ThomECC- Thomasian Employees' Credit Cooperative

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

We, the undersigned Filipino citizens, all of legal age and residents of the Philippines, have on this day voluntarily agreed to form a primary Multi-Purpose Employees' Cooperative, under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

ARTICLE I Name of the Cooperative

<u>That the name of this Cooperative shall be ThomECC - Thomasian Employees Credit</u> Cooperative or ThomECC for brevity.

ARTICLE II Objectives

That the objective for which this Cooperative is formed are:

<u>Primary</u>

That the primary purposes for which this Cooperative is organized are to engage in:

- 1. Generating funds and extending credit to the members for productive and provident purposes;
- 2. Encouraging thrift and savings mobilization among the members;
- 3. Providing protection to the loans and funds of the members;
- 4. Advocating for the cause of the cooperative movements;
- 5. Ensuring the viability of cooperatives through the utilization of new technologies; and
- <u>6. Encouraging and promoting self-help or self-employment as an engine for economic growth and poverty alleviation.</u>

Secondary

- 1. To attain increased income, savings, investments, productivity, and purchasing power, and promote among themselves equitable distribution of net surplus through maximum utilization of economies of scale, cost-sharing and risk-sharing;
- 2. To provide optimum social and economic benefits to its members;
- 3. To propagate Cooperative practices and innovative ideas in business undertakings and management;

- 4. To actively support the government, other Cooperatives and people oriented organizations, both local and foreign, in promoting Cooperatives as a practical means towards sustainable socio-economic development under a truly just and democratic society;
- 5. To develop a dynamic savings mobilization and capital build-up schemes to sustain its developmental activities and long-term investments, thereby ensuring optimum economic benefits to the members, their families and the communities;
- 6. To adopt membership expansion mechanism/scheme, thereby ensuring growth of the Cooperative movement;
- 7. To implement policy guidelines that will ensure transparency, accountability and equitable access to its resources and services, and promote the interests of the members;
- 8. To adopt such other plans as may help foster the welfare of the members, their families and the community;
- <u>9. To coordinate with other Cooperatives on learning exchanges, coop trade, and information exchanges in fostering sustainable development;</u>
- 10. To advocate legal framework and enabling policies appropriate for the development of credit Cooperatives; and
- 11. To be the voice and the institution of the poor and the excluded in resisting the growth-centered development aggression and instead promote people-centered development.

ARTICLE III Powers and Capacities

In the furtherance of and not in limitation to the powers and capacities conferred by Republic Act No. 9520, this Cooperative shall have the following juridical powers and capacities:

- 1. To draw, make, accept, endorse, guarantee, execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, debentures, bonds, drafts, warrants, certificates and all other kinds of obligations and instruments in connection with its lawful business operations;
- 2. To contract indebtedness and/or enter into joint ventures with local or foreign entities in order to achieve its goals and economic plans and programs;
- 3. To purchase, receive, take or grant, hold, convey, sell, lease, pledge, mortgage, and otherwise deal with such real and personal property as the transaction of its lawful affairs may reasonably and necessarily require, subject to the limitations prescribed by law and the Constitution of the Philippines.
- 4. To exercise such other powers as may be essential and necessary to carry out its objectives in accordance with law.

ARTICLE IV Area of Operation

That this Cooperative shall operate within the University of Santo Tomas, and its principal office shall be located in G/F main Bldg., UST, Espana, Sampaloc, Manila 1008.

ARTICLE V Term of Existence

That the term for which this Cooperative shall exist is Fifty (50) years from the date of its registration with the Cooperative Development Authority.

ARTICLE VI Common Bond of Membership

That the common bond of membership of this Cooperative is Institutional and shall be open to all natural persons who are Filipino citizens, of legal age, with the capacity to contract and possess all the qualifications and none of the disqualification provided for in the By-laws. Employees of UST.
